2019 President Message

The following is a summary of the 2019 Chiyoda employees New Year's message given by

Masaji Santo, President and CEO.

Chiyoda is at a turning point. Last year we suffered enormous additional costs on overseas

projects. Although mainly caused by changes in the external environment, the situation may

make some people question our raison d'etre. I want to emphasize three points for Chiyoda's

focus in 2019:

Firstly, we should complete all ongoing construction projects as planned. Although this is a

basic point, I wish to emphasize that this should be our first priority.

Secondly, we should reform our consciousness. Rather than regarding last year's losses as

occurring purely on overseas projects, we must recognize our organization's institutional and

structural fatigue that caused them. We should reform our consciousness, supported by

external specialists, to review how we manage costs, our sensitivity to risk, whether real or

potential negative information is immediately reported to managers and management.

Thirdly, we will focus more on digitalization, connecting our engineering excellence with digital

technology to create new business opportunities. The combined efforts of every employee will

become an unstoppable driving force promoting digitization from day to day working to new

business incubation.

Despite our issues, the market environment for new orders has improved and we received

warm support and encouragement from our clients. We are looking forward to this opportunity

for change. Change is essential and only companies that change will survive and be successful.

Maintaining our focus, we will strive for success again this year.
