Freeport LNG Train 1 Begins Commercial Operation

Chiyoda Corporation (TSE: 6366; ISIN: JP3528600004) is pleased to announce that the commercial operation of Train 1 of Freeport LNG project in Texas commenced on December 8, 2019.

For Chiyoda International Corporation (CIC), a U.S. based wholly-owned subsidiary of Chiyoda, and its partners on the project, McDermott International, Inc. and Zachry Group, this is a historic moment of the project with exceptional safety performance during the Construction phase. Feed gas was introduced into Freeport LNG Train 1 in July, the shipping of the first cargo from Train 1 was achieved in September and now commercial operation of Train 1 has commenced.

The project includes three liquefaction trains with a projected export capacity of approximately 15 million tons per annum of LNG, a second loading berth and a 165,000 m³ full containment LNG storage tank.

Freeport LNG Trains 2 and 3 remain on track to meet their previously announced schedules, with first liquid from Train 2 being announced on Dec. 9 and Train 3 initial production of LNG scheduled for Q1 of 2020.
