Construction of Tangguh Train 3 has completed safely.

Chiyoda Corporation (Chiyoda) is pleased to announce that Train 3 of the Tangguh Expansion Project (TEP) in Bintuni Bay, Papua Barat Province, Indonesia, has been completed safely and we would like to congratulate the client, BP Berau Ltd, on the shipment of the first cargo of LNG produced from Train 3 which has been delivered to the domestic market in Indonesia.

Chiyoda Corporation and PT. Chiyoda International Indonesia, an Indonesia based wholly-owned subsidiary of Chiyoda, and its joint venture partners on the project, PT. Saipem Indonesia, PT. Tripatra Engineers and Constructors, PT. Tripatra Engineering and PT. Suluh Ardhi Engineering, are proud of their project team for this achievement and for their exceptional safety performance during the construction phase.

The project includes one liquefaction train with a projected export capacity of 3.8 million tons per annum of LNG, an onshore receiving facility (ORF), a new LNG production facility and condensate loading jetty, additional boil off gas (BOG) recovery facilities, utilities, flares and the infrastructures.

Train 3 will increase Tangguh's total LNG production by 50% up to 11.4 million tons per annum.
