Chiyoda Corporation Awarded Study of CO₂ Liquefaction and Storage by J-POWER

Chiyoda Corporation (Chiyoda) is pleased to announce that it has been awarded a contract by Electric Power Development Co., Ltd. (J-POWER) to study CO₂ liquefaction and storage facilities.

J-POWER and seven other companies are participating in the Southern Malay Peninsula Offshore CCS project, commissioned by Japan Organization for Metals and Energy Security (JOGMEC) as the 'Engineering Design Work for Advanced CCS Projects' in FY2024. Chiyoda will conduct technical studies on CO₂ liquefaction and storage facilities for thermal power plants owned by J-POWER in the Kyushu region.

Chiyoda is actively engaged in the CCS field and is developing a CO₂ liquefaction plant based on our strength in low-temperature gas liquefaction technology, cultivated through the construction of natural gas liquefaction plants.

As an integrated engineering company, Chiyoda is engaged in CCS projects and the development of technologies to realize a carbon neutral society around the world, and will continue contributing to the development of a sustainable society in line with our mission of 'Energy and Environment in Harmony'.
