**Chiyoda Awarded an Energy Saving Study by NEDO
for the Ministry of Industry of Thailand**

Chiyoda Corporation (“Chiyoda”) (TSE: 6366; ISIN: JP3528600004), Japan’s leading engineering and construction firm, today announces that the New Energy and Industrial Technology Development Organization (“NEDO”) (Head Office: Kawasaki, Chairman: Kazuo Furukawa) has awarded Chiyoda an energy saving study for the Ministry of Industry of Thailand.

Chiyoda will conduct an energy saving study with the cooperation of IEAT^{*1} in Map Ta Phut Industrial Complex, Thailand, where there is a concentration of heavy and chemical industries. The advanced energy utilization analysis technology (pinch technology), which has been applied for energy saving studies to several large industrial complexes in Japan, will be adopted for multiple facilities in the complex. Through this study, Chiyoda will propose and develop a master plan and methods for energy saving among the multiple facilities in the complex. Chiyoda seeks to contribute to the establishment of an energy saving master plan for Thailand and to the efficient use of energy in “Smart Industrial Complexes”, and aims to apply this technology to realize large energy saving projects in other emerging countries.
