Chiyoda Presents an Energy Saving Plan to the Ministry of Industry of Thailand

Chiyoda Corporation (Chiyoda) (Head Office: Yokohama, President & CEO: Shogo Shibuya) (TSE: 6366, ISIN: JP3528600004) announces that Chiyoda has reported an energy efficiency plan to the Ministry of Industry of Thailand on September 24. This report, commissioned by the New Energy and Industrial Technology Development Organization ("NEDO") (Head Office: Kawasaki, Chairman: Kazuo Furukawa), is intended to improve the overall energy efficiency at Map Ta Phut Industrial Estate in Thailand.

1. Client : NEDO

2. Scope of Work : Energy Saving Study for the Ministry of Industry of Thailand

3. Schedule : Started fiscal year 2011, Ends fiscal year 2013.

Chiyoda conducted a study using its own "Area-Wide Pinch Technology" to achieve high efficiency energy saving, which has previously been verified in industrial complexes in Japan. Chiyoda performed a diagnosis for energy saving and an analysis for energy usage, in cooperation with IEAT* in the Map Ta Phut Industrial Complex, Thailand, where it was expected there to be a high potential for energy saving in the Complex as a whole, and completed a report that proposed possible energy saving solutions involving multiple manufacturers in the Complex. Chiyoda estimates that the total energy consumption can be cut by up to 30% in this area. Furthermore, based on this result, Chiyoda will promote possible projects to improve energy efficiency among multiple manufacturers.

While Chiyoda Group is active in the field of realizing energy saving projects, we also aim to develop "Smart Industrial Complexes" that optimize the efficient use of energy by applying our technology in emerging countries throughout the world.
