Hydride Method utilizing unused energy so far

3. Program Duration: Phase I Until the end of February 2017

Phase II Until the end of February 2021

4. Program Description: Through the continuous operation of the demonstration plant installed

in our Koyasu Research Park, we have already successfully completed

demonstration operation of Hydrogenation and Dehydrogenation.

By utilizing this support program of NEDO, we will determine particular issues which we will have to solve and provide countermeasures against them in order to establish and smoothly operate the future

Hydrogen Supply Chain utilizing the currently unused energy.

In the phase $\ I$, in order to verify the underlying technologies required for the smooth operation of the overall Hydrogen Supply Chain, we will study on scale up of the plants, durability of catalysts and overall

operability of the Hydrogen Supply Chain.

5. Execution Framework: Phase I will be executed as is mentioned above. The phase II will be decided later.

We will continue to concentrate on earlier establishment of large scale supply chain of Hydrogen, so called ultimate energy, and wish to contribute to the realization of the Hydrogen Society.
